Simmons Library and ADA Compliance Policy

The Simmons Library building was built in 1900, has landmark status, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The cost of providing handicapped accessibility to the Simmons Library would pose an unreasonable burden on the Kenosha Public Library. Services provided by the Simmons Library are also provided by the Kenosha Public Library at other city locations, which are handicapped accessible. The Kenosha Public Library provides reasonable accommodations at its other libraries for those who are physically unable to come to the Simmons Library.

The Kenosha Public Library will provide access to the library service program provided by the Simmons Library for handicapped individuals by routing Simmons Library circulating materials to an accessible Kenosha Public Library for patron pickup.

The Kenosha Public Library normally does not schedule unique programming at the Simmons Library. However, due to the historical significance of the building, some tours are unique to that location.
